Recommended seasonal vaccines for infants, children and pregnant people.
Additional vaccines may be recommended according to the CDC's Immunization Schedules

	What are the options?	Who is eligible?	When should I get it?
INFLUENZA 	<p>A trivalent vaccine that targets 3 different influenza viruses</p>	<p>Those 6 months and older; pregnant persons</p>	<p>October is ideal, as vaccine protection wanes over a season</p>
COVID-19 	<p>An updated 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccine Options: Moderna and Pfizer (mRNA) and Novavax (protein)</p>	<p>Those 6 months and older; pregnant persons</p>	<p>Beginning in September 2024</p>
RSV IN PREGNANCY 	<p>A single dose of the maternal RSV vaccine Options: Pfizer's Abrysvo vaccine</p>	<p>Pregnant persons 32 0/7 weeks through 36 6/7 weeks gestation</p>	<p>September 2024 - January 2024</p>
RSV ANTIBODY 	<p>A monoclonal antibody, nirsevimab. This is not a vaccine but rather a proactive immunization that provides antibodies Options: Beyfortus</p>	<p>All infants < 8 months. High-risk infants 8-19 months</p>	<p>At birth starting October 2024-March 2025</p>
